Ba-Phalaborwa Municipality will be embarking on a mass Indigent registration on **28 MAY 2022 to 29 MAY 2022** for the Indigent Register. Registration centres throughout Ba-Phalaborwa Municipality have been identified and communities are invited to register at the registration points between the above dates.

Approved Indigent households will receive free basic services such as 6 KL water and 50KWH of electricity and 100% rebates on other basic services per month for the duration of a year in terms of the Indigent Policy. Kindly take note of the Indigent policy and more specifically on the fact that any consumption above the threshold shall be payable by the consumer.

The following criteria apply if a household wants to register as indigent:


- ❖ The total gross monthly income of all members of the household does not exceed two old age state pensioners income of R 3970.00 per month
- ❖ The person/applicant applying on behalf of a household must be 18 years of age and above
- ❖ Written proof for child headed household consumer or properties inherited must be provided (from social worker).
- ❖ The person/applicant applying on behalf of a household must reside at that property
- ❖ The person/applicant applying should be the owner of the property
- ❖ The person/applicant must be a South African Citizen.
- ❖ Certified copies of the following should accompany the applications:
 - ❖ Identity document of applicant, spouse and all dependants
 - ❖ Proof of income/sworn affidavit if unemployed (in case of social grant provide receipt showing figures)
 - ❖ Latest municipal account (where applicable)
 - ❖ The account holder's and spouse certified identity documents
 - ❖ Proof of marital status (e.g. marriage certificate, divorce certificate or customary union/living together, death certificate where applicable)
 - ❖ Prepaid electricity receipt or token (Eskom supplied area)

N.B PROVIDE CERTIFIED DOCUMENTS NOT OLDER THAN THREE MONTHS.


