### INVITATION

Registrations are restricted to the local municipality in which the company or individual resides. Successful companies **will be considered** for installation of government subsidized STB decoder installation in the respective local municipalities.

### REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICANTS

- Certified copy of South African ID book/Smart ID Card.
- Certified copy of installer certificate from a recognized institution.
- Police Clearance Certificate or receipt showing application of clearance.
- Proven track record in the domestic satellite/terrestrial television installations.
- Applicants must reside in the local municipality of the project (provide proof of residence e.g. rates and taxes or letter from the Councillor)
- People with installation experience without accreditation are also encouraged to apply.

Installers are expected to register within their local municipality offices by no later than 26 February 2021
