Limpopo observe International day for persons with disabilities

Limpopo Government will this year celebrate International Day for persons with disabilities at Namakgale, Ba-Phalaborwa Municipality under the theme "Celebrating 60 years of the Freedom Charter: South Africa – a free and just society inclusive of all persons with disabilities as equal citizens".

The annual observance of the International Day of Persons with Disabilities on 03rd December, aims to promote an understanding of disability issues, to promote the rights of persons with disabilities and to promote gains to be derived from the integration of persons with disabilities in every aspect of the political, social, economic and cultural life of their communities.

The day provides an opportunity to mobilise action to achieve the goal of full and equal enjoyment of human rights and participation in society by persons with disabilities, established by the World Programme of Action concerning Disabled Persons, adopted by the United Nations General Assembly in 1982.
