

IMPLEMENTATION OF SUPPLY CHAIN MANGEMENT POLICY REPORT THIRD QUARTER JANUARY – MARCH 2019

Executive Summary

Introduction

This report is a summary of the implementation of the Supply Chain Management Policy. It highlights the implementation of Supply Chain Management in the Ba-Phalaborwa Municipality. Regulation 6(3) of the SCM Regulations requires the Accounting Officer to report on the implementation of the Supply Chain Management Policy to the Mayor in a bid to give effect to his oversight role.

Policy

The Supply Chain Management Policy was reviewed and adopted by Council in May of 2018 to fully comply with the SCM Regulations communicated under National Treasury general. The Supply Chain Management Policy will be reviewed annually to ensure alignment with legislative amendments and to incorporate any recommendations as raised by the Auditor General.

Systems

Central Supplier Database

The municipality is currently operating on the centralised supplier database for the commodities or items that are procured within the institutions.

The request for quotation are advertised on the website so that all the service providers who are registered on the centralised supplier database may bid.

Ba-Phalaborwa Municipality has embarked on a process where it encourages new prospective service providers to register on the CSD to comply with paragraph 14 (1) (ii) of the Supply Chain Management Regulations, which requires the accounting officer to invite prospective providers of goods and services to apply for evaluation and listing as accredited prospective providers irrespective where the bidder comes from.
