EXTENTION FOR INSPECTION OF THE VALUATION ROLL AND LODGING OF OBJECTIONS

Notice is hereby given in terms of Section 49 (1) (a) (i) of the Local Government: Municipal Property Rates Act, 2004 (Act No. 6 of 2004), hereinafter referred to as the "Act", that the inspection for the valuation roll for the financial years 1 July 2025 to 30 June 2030 has been extended, to 18 April 2025. The valuation roll is available for public inspection at the municipal venues listed below:

An invitation is hereby made in terms of Section 49 (1) (a) (ii) of the Act that any property owner who so desires should lodge an objection with the Municipal Manager in respect of any matter reflected in, or omitted from, the Valuation Roll within the above-mentioned period. Any person who cannot read or write may come to the municipal offices (Namakgale Flea Market, Along R71) where officials in the Town Planning and Human Settlement Unit will assist that person in transcribing their comments or representations.

Attention is specifically drawn to the fact that in Section 50 (2) of the Act, an objection must be about a specific individual property and not against the Valuation Roll. The form for the lodging of an objection is obtainable at the following addresses:
