2. The Energy Regulator at its meeting held on 04 May 2026 considered your Cost of Supply based application for a tariff increase for the period 1 July 2026 - 30 June 2027 and approved the tariffs as follows:

3. The Energy Regulator further directs as follows:

3.1 The municipality must submit a report accounting for all the costs that have been noted in its COS study, to enable the Regulator to perform its independent verification/audit process by 31 January 2027.

3.2 The municipality must submit a quarterly smart efficiency plan with improvements measures identified in reducing all losses and submit by 30 September 2026.

4. NERSA has approved the tariffs while considering all relevant, material and lawful factors applicable to the execution of its mandate to ensure that Ba-Phalaborwa Municipality implements lawful tariffs. Section 15(2) of the Electricity Regulation Act, 2006 (Act No. 4 of 2006), as amended, prohibits the charging of any tariff to any customer unless it has been approved by NERSA.
