#### INTRODUCTION:

The Ba-Phalaborwa Municipality envisaged the completion of the **REMOVAL OF EXISTING ASPHALT AND INSTALLATION OF THE PAVEMENT BLOCK AT ZORBA PARKING AREA IN PHALABORWA TOWN IN WARD 12.** The Pavement blocks to be installed is 60mm thick. The total area to be paved is 2000m<sup>2</sup> and the duration of the project is two (2) months. The benefits of the pavement at Zorba parking are as follows:

- Simple maintenance requirements for concrete pavement.
- Good drainage property even on flat slopes.
- · Good resistance to deformation.
- Both the parking-stall and the traffic lane can be incorporated.
- Concrete pavement is less affected by the leaking oil and petroleum products from the vehicle.
- And the community at large will have easy access to the Zorba complex
- The Zorba complex will attract more business in the future

The contract shall cover inter alia the following:

#### Phalaborwa town Ward 12

- Demolish and clearing of the existing asphalt pavement
- Removing the damaged kerbs and replacing with new kerbs
- Construction of layer works.
- Installation of 60mm pavement blocks

#### PS-2 DESCRIPTION OF THE SITE AND ACCESS

#### 2.1 Location of site

The limits of the project are as shown on the locality plan.

The site of works is located in Phalaborwa town Grey street near Laer skool Phalaborwa North, Latitude -23° 93'47.70" S Longitude 31° 13' 46.60"E

#### 2.2 Access to site

The contractor shall be responsible for the maintenance and reinstatement of damage caused by him or his agents/deliveries to vehicular access tracks and rights of way. No damage to fauna and flora located outside the limits of the Zorba area will be permitted on the contract.

The contractor shall take cognizance of the aforementioned items concerning roads and tracks and allow for any costs in his bid under the relevant section in the bill of quantities.

#### PS-3 DETAILS OF THE WORKS AND TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

- Removal of asphalt
- Rip and compact the base using the In-situ Material 150mm layer @95% Mod-AASHTO
- Compaction test results will be required
- Soil poisoning on the base layer
- 20mm bedding of sand before installation of the 60mm pavement blocks
- · Grouting the entire square metres of the newly layed pavement
- Parking markings
- · Cleaning and Finishing
