- Present various solutions, alternative and/ or options that address the engineering problems encountered during the initial stage of feasibility studies;
- Joint selection of the most economic and sustainable option with low cost maintenance implication that
 is in line with national standards and meets the specific circumstances and needs within each
 community.
- The feasibility study and investigation exercise should address relocation of services if there are any and further make engagements with relevant stakeholders such as Eskom, Telkom, ect.

TAX CLEARANCE CERTIFICATE
