POST OFFICE STRIKE

Phalaborwa Traffic Department wishes to inform you about the impact of the South African Post Office strike.

According to a press release by South African Post Office, mail delivery in four centres - Gauteng, Bloemfontein, Cape Town and Polokwane – is hampered by unprotected industrial action and incidents of intimidation which began on 18 August in Gauteng.

As a result, all mail originating from and going to these areas are mostly affected, as are Phalaborwa Traffic Fines which are also generated to and correspondence by post received from an affected area.

SMS reminders are being sent in respect of outstanding traffic fines. However, if we do not have sufficient contact details on record we shall not be able to contact you.

We therefore urge the public to contact our offices if they suspect, or to enquire whether there are any outstanding Traffic Fines (speed cameras) in the Ba-Phalaborwa area which you might not be aware of, or to confirm that your representations and /or payments sent by post have in fact been received by us.
